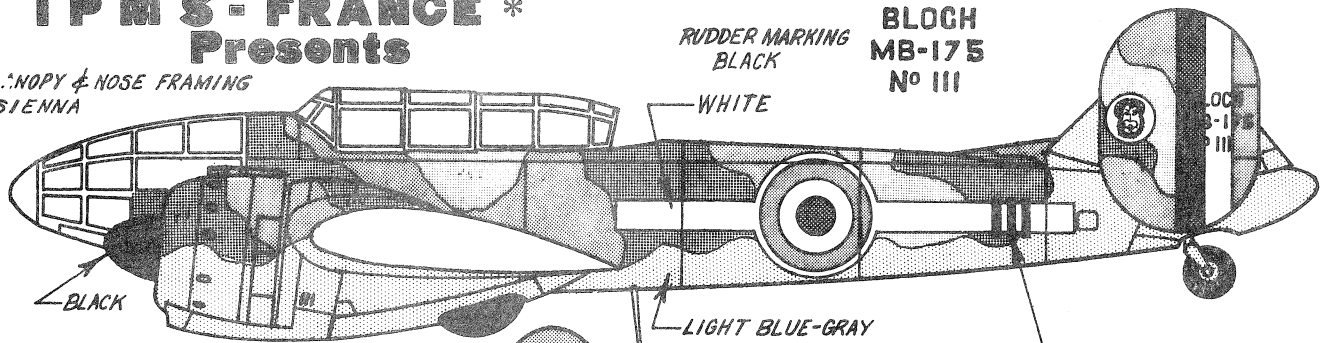

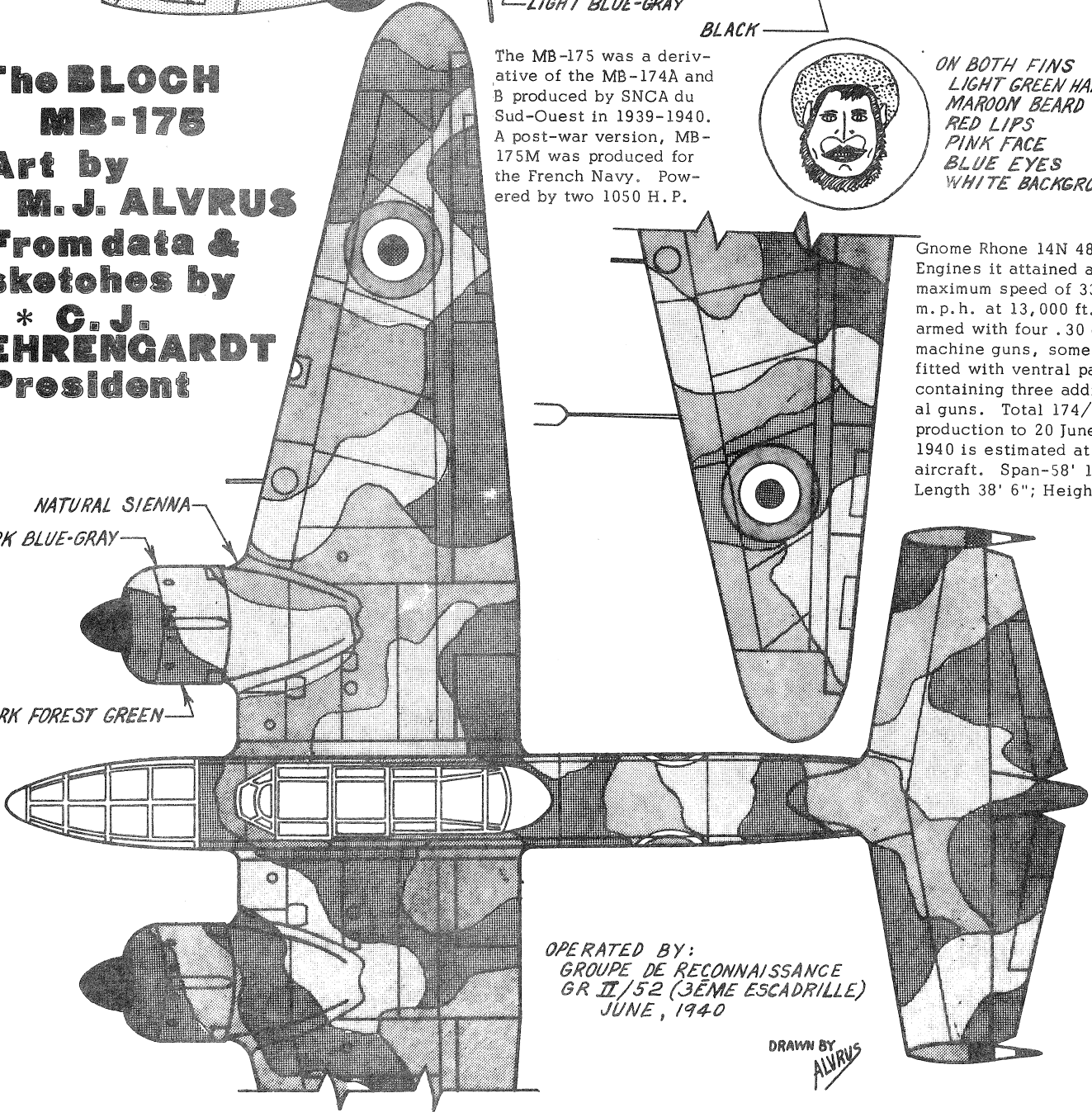

Gnome Rhone 14N 48/49 Engines it attained a maximum speed of 335 m. p. h. at 13,000 ft. armed with four .30 cal. machine guns, some were fitted with ventral packs containing three additional guns. Total 174/175 production to 20 June 1940 is estimated at 218 aircraft. Span-58' 10"; Length 38' 6"; Height 12'.
