

NEWS FLASHES

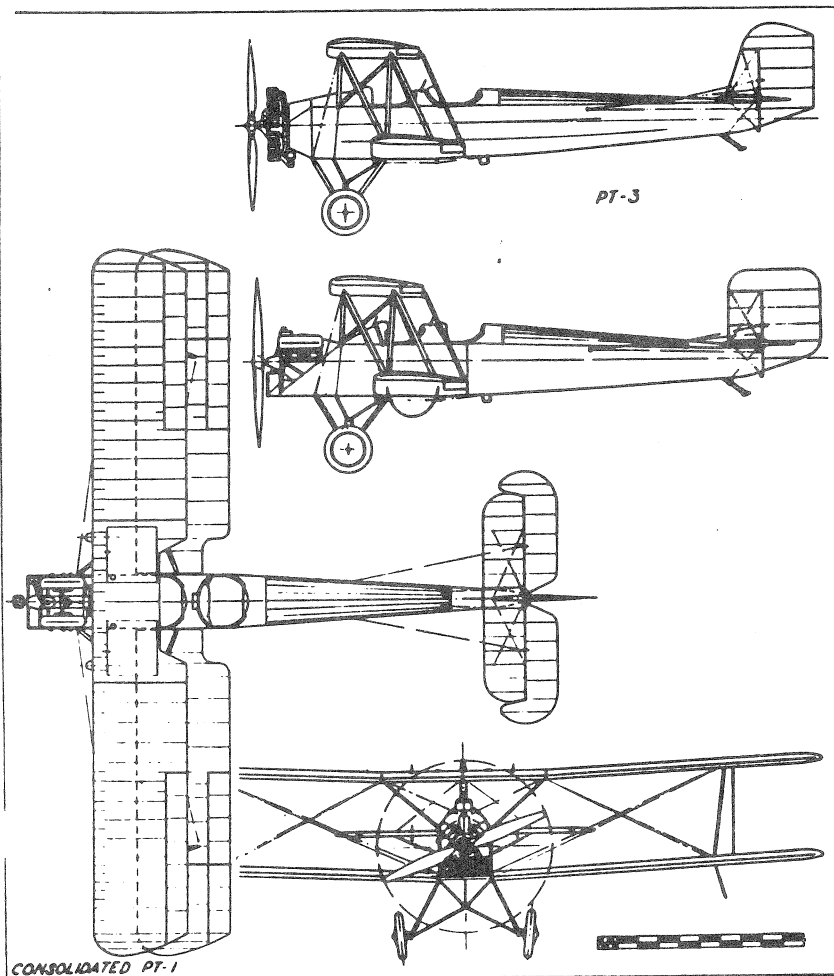

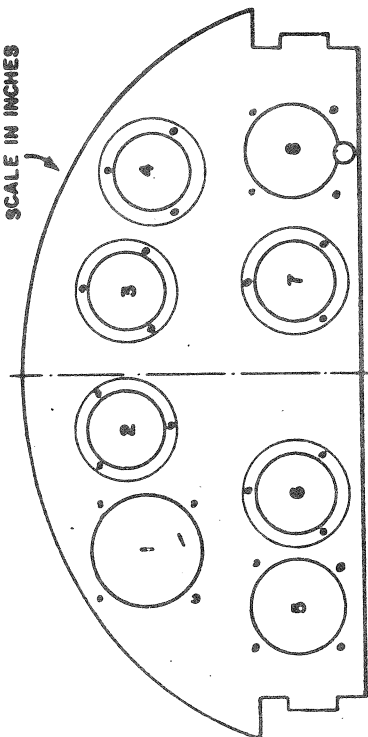
What we are doing, however, is producing a line of plans dedicated to the old concept of fun-to-build, attractive models of interesting aircraft."
