placement parts for any component of the airplane can be carried in the cargo compartment of the fuselage. A detailed presentation of each major component is given in this manual. For instructions on assembly and disassembly of these major components, refer to the Handbook of Erection and Maintenance Instructions for this airplane, T. O. No. 01-251B-2.

The C-76 airplane is a twin-engine, high wing monoplane-type transport of all-wood construction. It is equipped with a tricycle-type landing gear. The major component parts of the airplane are so designed that they, in turn, can be broken down into quickly detached components, as shown on the Breakdown Drawings. With the exception of the fuselage itself, re-

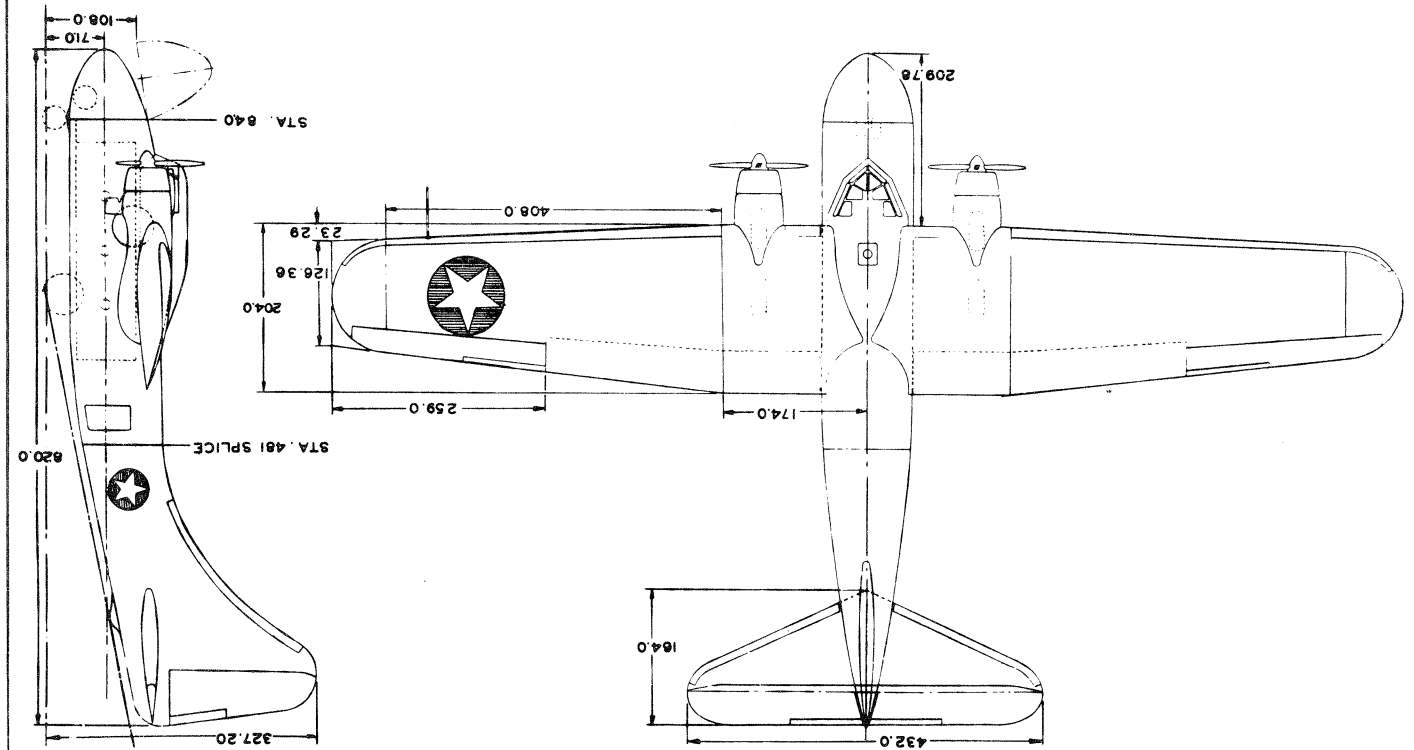


Figure 2 - General Assembly - Three View
