Areas not marked on drawing are painted as follows:

GLOSSY INSIGNIA WHITE:

Landing gear (except oleos), inside of main and nosewheel doors and wheel wells, lower surfaces of wing flap recesses, lower surface and outboard end of slats, and inside of airscoop from three inches aft of inlet.

GLOSSY INSIGNIA RED:

Inside surfaces of flaps and speed brakes, top surface of slat recess and inboard end of slats.

UNPAINTED:

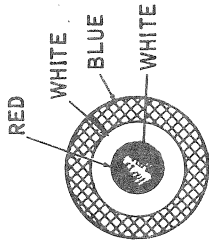
Refueling probe tip, instrument static channel, tailpipe fairing and eyelid.

NOTES:
Camouflage colors and pattern conform to standard USAF camouflage markings.

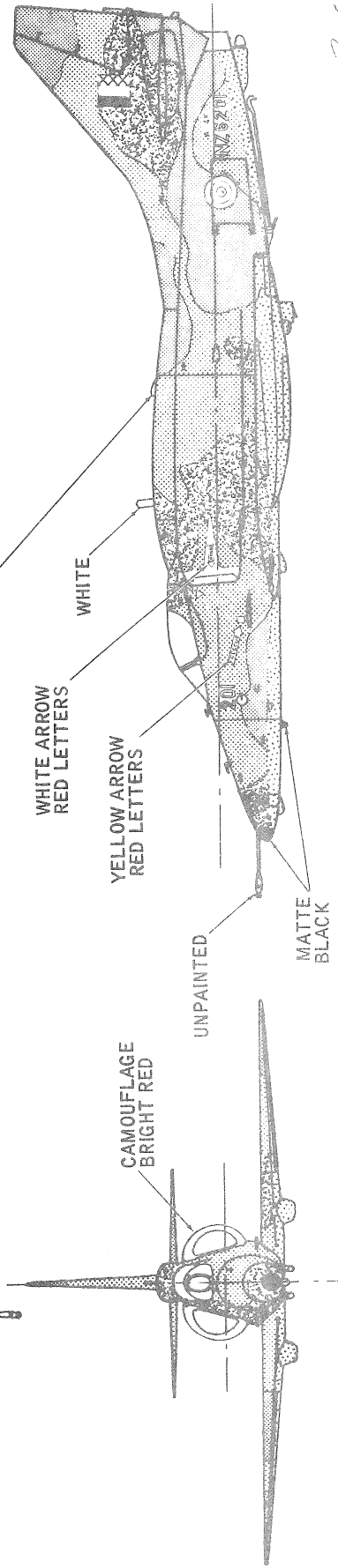
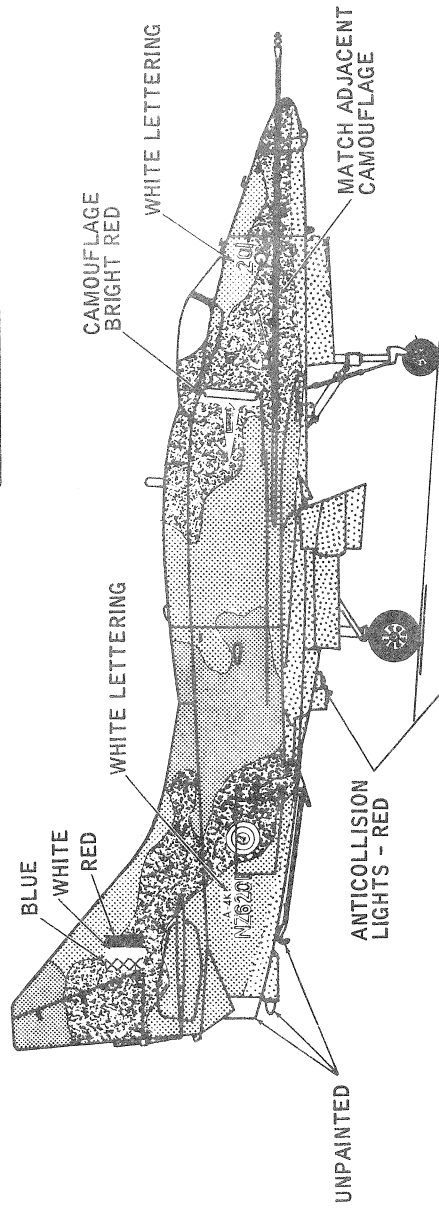
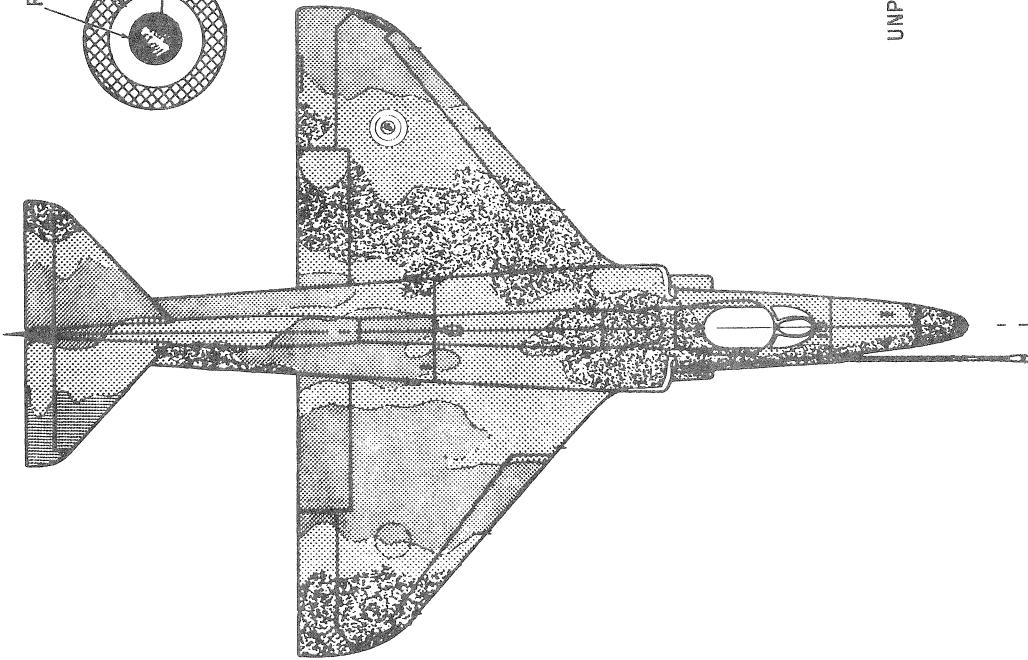
Camouflage colors are blended by overspraying. Pattern may vary from that shown by as much as six inches.

Insignia Fernleaf points up on fuselage, forward on wings.

Arresting gear alternate four-inch black and white stripes, tip unpainted.
