



## FOKKER D. XXIII

The D. XXIII fighter was built in 1939 and had an unusual design, with a tandem engine arrangement of two Walter Sagittas of 528 h. p. and twin-tailbooms.

The D. XXIII was an experimental aircraft for a modern heavily armed twin engine fighter to be equipped with either Rolls-Royce Merlin, Mercedes-Benz or Isotta Fraschini water-cooled engines.

The outbreak of W. W. II prevented development of this type. Only one was built and flown.

Type: All-metal single-seat twin-engine fighter.
