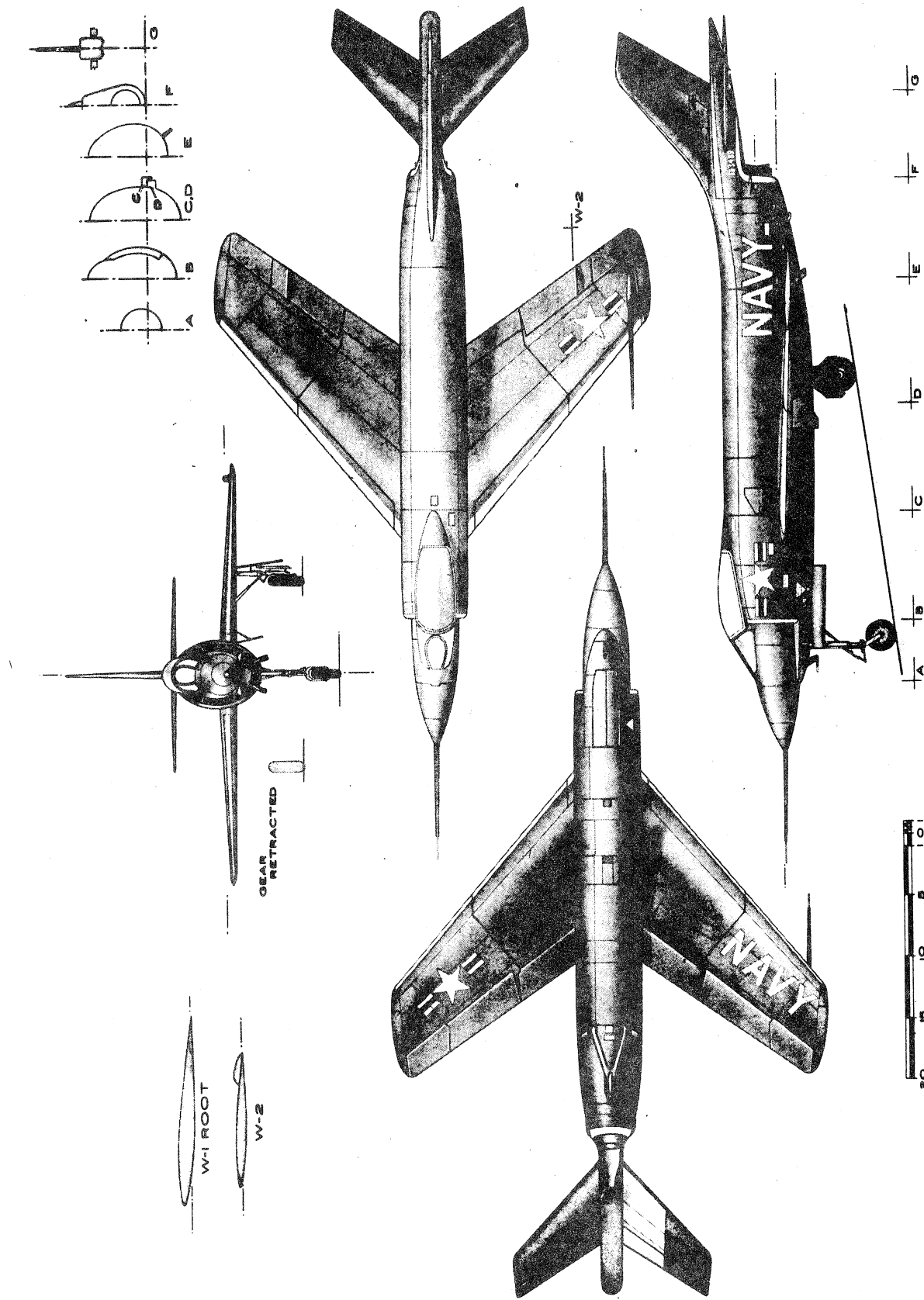


McDONNELL F3H-1N "DEMON"



■ After three years of intensive flight testing, McDonnell's Demon now in production is being delivered to the Navy to operate from carriers as an all-weather fighter and bomber armed with 20 mm cannon or a variety of bombs and rockets. First batch of Demons had Westinghouse J-40

7200 lb. turbo engines with afterburners; later models will be equipped with Allison J-71s of somewhat greater thrust. Despite bulk, F3H-1N can climb over 10,000 feet per minute and hit supersonic speed. Its gross weight is approximately the same as that of the DC-3, while wingspan is 35 ft. 4 in.
